5. AEC Meeting with Eniwetok Representatives (Contact: AGMMA)

On May 31, 1973, representatives of the Eniwetok people conferred in Las Vegas with members of the Nevada Operations Office, the Lawrence Livermore Laboratory, and the University of Washington. These representatives were Mr. Theodore Mitchell and Mr. Hemos Jack of the Micronesian Legal Services Corporation and Mr. Smith Gideon, Magistrate of Ujelang Atoll--the current residence of the Eniwetokese. In general, they endorsed the AEC radiological survey as being well planned and executed. Also, they expressed approval of NV plans for a small party to visit Ujelang in late June 1973 to study the probable lifestyle patterns of the resettled Eniwetokese.

In response to interest in an early radiological certification and some resettlement of Japtan, one of the southern islands of the atoll, NV furnished specific data as to external exposure rates on Japtan. It was stressed that no definitive judgements concerning constraints on the return of the native people to Japtan could be made until assessment of food-chain pathways was complete and that this portion of the survey would not be completed before late summer 1973.
