**OPERATIONS PLAN
MISSION NO. 87-6
EBEYE, MAJURO, UTERIK, MEJATO**

I. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

Brookhaven National Laboratory has conducted medical surveillance on Rongelap and Uterik persons who were exposed to fallout from the 1954 nuclear event BRAVO. A control group of unexposed persons is also monitored for comparison data. Ship supported medical missions will be carried out on board the DOE vessel, the Liktanur III, at all locations (except Ebeye where the vessel will anchor to provide support as needed to the medical team working at DOE's shoreline facilities). This will be the fifth visit to Mejato Island, an island in Kwajalein Atoll to which the Rongelap population moved in May 1985.

II. WORK TO BE PERFORMED

A. Complete examination of all I.D. card holder patients, who were not examined in the spring.

B. Follow-up work on patients, who were examined in the spring and have ongoing medical problems.

C. SICK CALL will be available ashore at Uterik and Mejato for anyone desirous.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES

The Party Chief will be Dr. William Adams who will be responsible for all medical aspects of the mission. William Jackson, Program Liaison Specialist, will serve as Department of Energy representative and spokesman on policy matters. In addition, he will provide logistical assistance to BNL as required and deal with U.S. Oceanography on behalf of BNL on all substantive matters.

IX. REPORTS

The Party Chief is to provide a report on the mission no later than 30 days after completion of the operation to the Director, PASO, with an information copy to the Assistant for Off-Continent Operations, NV. This report should be concise and cover all pertinent information such as adequacy of support and offer any comments or recommendations which will improve future operations.
