Within the Atoll of Enwetak, the island of Enwetak is the traditional dwelling place for the People of Enwetak, and

Enghdi Island is the traditional residence island of the People of Enghdi, and

It is of vital importance to the People of Enghdi to re-establish their homes upon Enghdi Island; and

All of the people of Enwetak Atoll fervently hope and pray that the People of Enghdi will be assisted by the United States of America in achieving the fulfillment of their desire; and

Representatives of the Department of Energy have explained the radiological conditions which exist at Enghdi Island; and

The People of Enwetak and Enghdi have carefully considered the radiological report of the Department of Energy; and

Resolution of the Ujelang/Enewetak Council

Whereas, a number of buildings on Enewetak dating from the test period will not be removed but remain to be used by the dri Enewetak; many of these structures have suffered severe weather damage to their roofs which, if unrepaired, will shorten their useful life span; and existing contracts require the repair of only those buildings designated for specific community activities and purposes,

Be it resolved that the People of Enewetak request that:

1. The FFPF commission ... a survey of all buildings which are presently designated to remain on Enewetak Atoll but the repair of which is not covered by existing contracts and which are in need of repair; the cost of such repairs to be estimated and a list of such estimated roof repair contracts to be prepared and submitted presently exist. This estimate should be based on the use, where feasible, of material from similar buildings scheduled for demolition.
2. The FFPF upon receipt of this estimate should contract for the repairs described in Paragraph 1 prior to the completion of the rehabilitation project on April 30, 1979.

We hereby certify that the foregoing was duly adopted by the Ujelang/Enewetak Council on the *18th* day of September, 1979.

Resolution of the Ujaelangi/Fnevetak Council

Whereas, the Fnevetak Atoll Rehabilitation Project has reached its final and critical phase, where the People of Fnevetak must have an even greater role in both the planning of future activities as well as supervising actual clean-up and rehabilitation activities;

Whereas, there has been an undue overpricing the location of certain houses and the allocation of certain supplies, protection and further construction will result in substantial loss of time and money; and

Whereas, the presence of the Fnevetak Planning Council on Fnevetak would provide the necessary leadership for the project work and planning to be done by the People of Fnevetak and provide the cooperation and involvement on their responsible for the rehabilitation activities with day to day guidance and a meaningful way of communicating with the deji Fnevetak on Ujaelangi; It is resolved that the People of Fnevetak require the following:

1. The six members of the Fnevetak Planning Council be permitted to be present on Fnevetak Island for the four month period ending on 31, 1979 or January 31, 1980.
2. The use of Ujaelangi as a subject to deal with the rehabilitation, however, there is no to be established a communication center there to be provided by the local people any of the facilities related to the rehabilitation activities.
3. The Planning Council to be based on Ujaelangi Island where they will be readily available to the various

contractors and government agencies personnel working on the rehabilitation project.

4. Each agency and contractor submit a brief plan or letter outlining the steps they will take to effectively utilize the planning Council during this four month period.

Resolution of The People's Ujeling Council
Concerning Plantings on Japanese Islands

Whereas the Master Plan for the Rehabilitation of Newetak Atoll requires that breadfruit trees should be planted in close proximity to homesteads; and the exigencies of the people on Ujelang has been that palms and plantings should be near the ocean side of each island and planted in rows the rows from coconut palms; and that coconut and breadfruit plantings do not grow well when interposed within the rows planting rows and therefore any of the plantings which had been set laid out on Ujelan Island have been removed because of well advanced inter-ference within the rows and the breadfruit trees are located adjacent from the homesteads.

It is hereby stated that the People's Ujeling Council requests that:

1. The Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (hereafter T.T.P.I.) in conformity with the Master Plan require the contractors for all future plantings of breadfruit on Japanese islands to place them in the closest proximity feasible to homesteads and to refrain from interposing coconut palm and breadfruit plantings within the rows.
2. The T.T.P.I. require in all future plantings on Japanese islands that breadfruit be spaced on the ocean side of each row and that breadfruit be spaced on the land side of each row.
3. The T.T.P.I. require that any breadfruit whose plantings have been planted on the ocean side of each island, but

the trees have not been planted, that these planting sites be relocated so they conform to the planting patterns described in Paragraphs 1 and 2 above.
